1. AFE Utilities

1.1. The AFE Utilities section focuses on setting “is Tight Hole” for selected AFE’s. The GUI shows a list of AFE’s, their objective, work type, and whether or not it is already identified as Tight Hole. Once an AFE is selected to be Tight Hole then the GUI allows access to the user access information section of the GUI. This allows an administrator to pick users from a list and add them to the permitted user list. (See figure 1.1)
